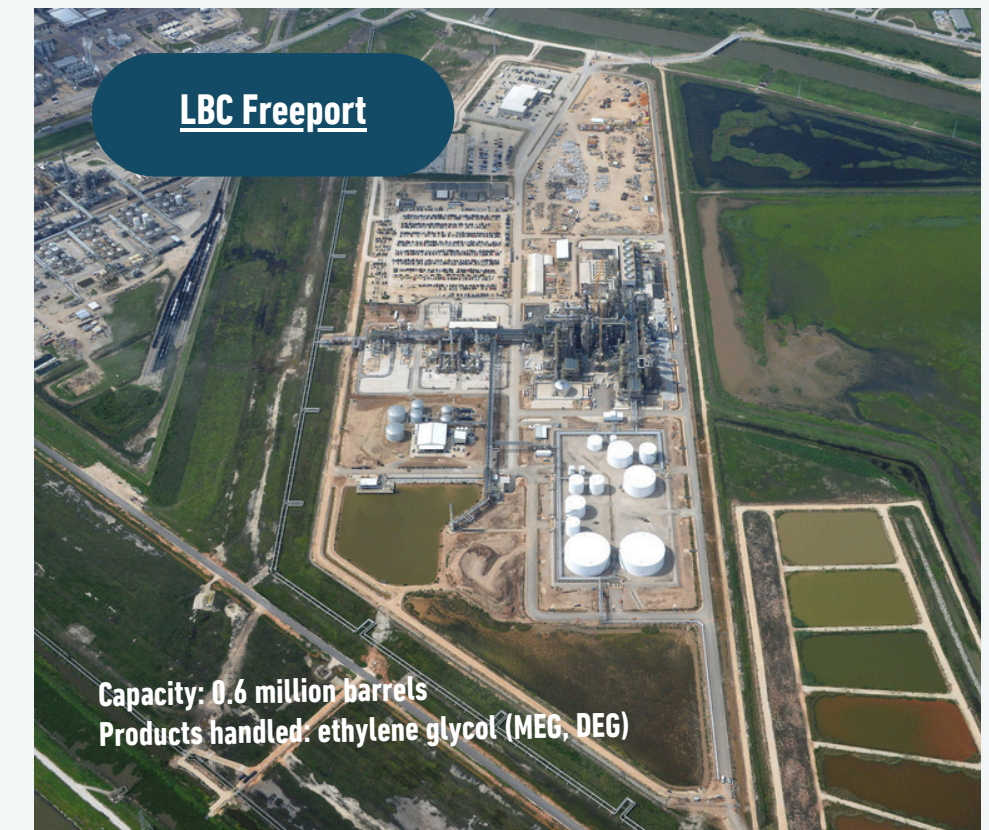
Ready for the future

A leading storage network across the U.S. Gulf Coast

In the U.S., we own and operate four deep-water marine terminals with a total storage capacity of 2.5 million m³ (~16 million barrels).







- **LBC Houston** – Situated on the Houston Ship Channel, connected to the Bayport Industrial Complex via over 30 pipelines.
- **Seabrook Logistics** – A crude import/export terminal with pipeline access to major refining and distribution networks.
- **LBC Baton Rouge** – Located in the Geismar industrial complex, serving as a distribution hub for the upper Mississippi River industrial area.
- **LBC Freeport** – A new, fit-for-purpose terminal providing storage and distribution for ethylene glycol production.

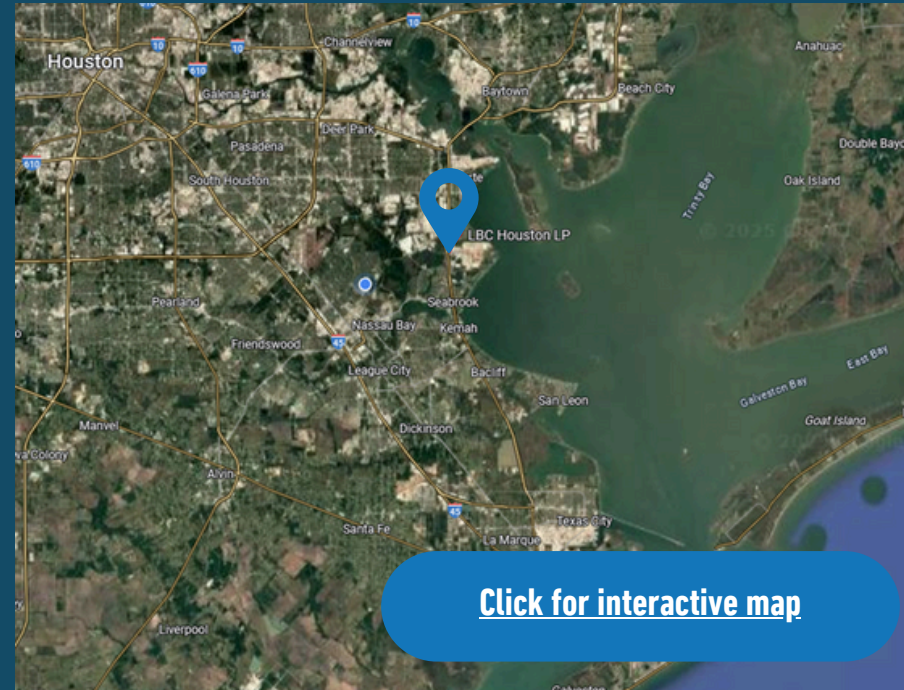


LBC Houston

Where connectivity meets storage excellence

Strategically located in Galveston Bay, the Houston terminal is a key logistics hub with direct pipeline connectivity to the Bayport Industrial Complex.

-  **Total tanks:** 189 | **Total capacity:** 8.1 million barrels
-  **Ship & barge docks:** 3 ship docks | 5 barge docks (12.2m draft)
-  **Truck & rail infrastructure:** 7 truck racks
-  9 rail tracks (113 rail spots)
-  17 LBC-owned **pipelines** + 12 additional interconnections
-  **Products:** chemicals, petroleum products, oils
- Value-added services** include drumming, direct transfer, vapour recovery, nitrogen blanketing, product heating (steam coils), refrigeration



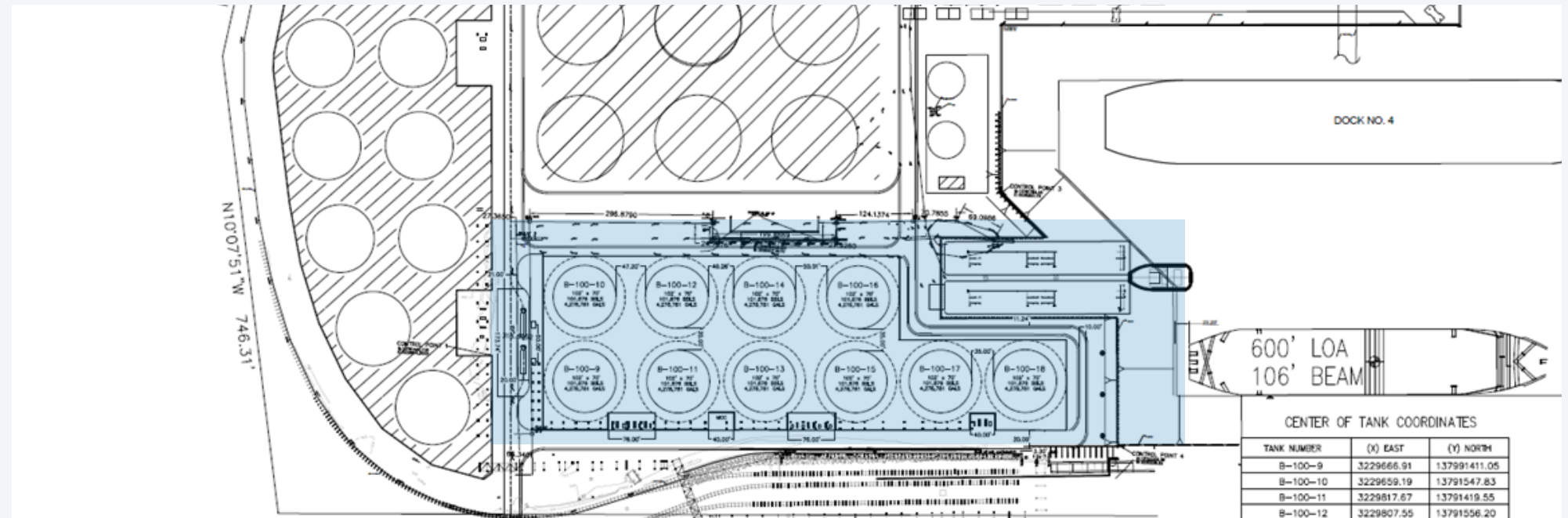
Driving growth

LBC Houston expansion

Phase 1 of the expansion includes **nine new 100,000-bbl carbon steel internal floating roof tanks** and **two additional barge docks**, significantly increasing storage and marine access. Designed for maximum operational flexibility, the expansion scope includes **vessel, barge, truck, rail, and tank-to-tank transfer** as modes of transport, ensuring seamless product movement.

Each tank will feature **dedicated lines** with **direct marine access** for both **barges and oceangoing vessels**, while **multiple crossover lines** will be constructed to add maximum flexibility.

The project is on track for completion in **Q1 2026**.
